From North on US 1:

Take US 1 South to Vero Beach. Turn Right (West) on State Road 60 (Also called 20th Place). Turn Left (South) on 14th Avenue. Turn Right (West) into the first driveway/Alley. Drive straight ahead for 200 feet, and park behind our building. Gray building with green awnings.

From North on I-95:

Take the Vero Beach exit. At bottom of exit ramp, turn Left (East) onto State Road 60. Go straight on SR 60 for about 6 miles. As you enter the downtown Vero Beach area, SR 60 divides into one-way streets. Just after you pass 16th Avenue, look for a small public parking sign on the left and turn into that parking lot. Our building (Gray with green awnings) is directly in front of you.

From the South on US 1:

Take US 1 North to State Road 60 (Also called 20th Place). Turn Left (West) on SR 60. Travel about 2 miles and turn Left (South) on 14th Avenue. Turn Right (West) into the first driveway/alley. Drive straight about 200 feet and park behind our building. Gray building with green awnings.

From the South on I-95:

Take I-95 to the Okeechobee Rd. East exit. At the base of the exit ramp, turn Right (West). Drive about 1/2 mile and turn Right (North) on Kings Highway. Drive about 5 miles until you reach U.S. #1. Turn Left (North) on U.S. 1. Drive about 7 miles until you reach State Road 60 (Also called 20th Place). Turn Left (West) on SR 60. Travel about 2 miles and turn Left (South) on 14th Avenue. Turn Right (West) into the first driveway/alley. Drive straight about 200 feet and park behind our building. Gray building with green awnings.

From the Turnpike:

Exit the Turnpike at Yeehaw Junction. After passing through the toll booth, turn Left (East) on State Road 60. Drive for about 25 miles. As you enter the downtown Vero Beach area, SR 60 divides into a one-way street. Just after you pass 16th Avenue, look for a small public parking sign on the left and turn into that parking lot.
